Present Simple



Present Continuous



S + verb

S + am/is/are (not) + V-ing

Express general truths

E.g: It rarely rains in the desert.

Describe actions happening now

E.g: She is reading a newspaper upstairs.

Indicate present habits

E.g: The birds return to the island every morning.

Express annoying habits (+ always)

E.g: You're always forgetting to pay the bills.

Express timetable events

E.g: The plane to London takes off at 6:30 a.m.

Describe future arrangements

E.g: She's getting married on 3 November.

Indicate permanent states

E.g: I like the new James Bond film.

Express temporary states

E.g: She's working at the museum until the end of this month.



PRESENT SIMPLE

POSITIVE

I/You/We/They work

He/She/It works

NEGATIVE

I/You/We/They don't work

He/She/It doesn't work

QUESTION

Do I/you/we/they } work?
Does he/she/it }

SHORT ANSWER

Yes, { I/you/we/they do
he/she/it does

No, { I/you/we/they don't
he/she/it doesn't

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

POSITIVE

I am working

You/We/They are working

He/She/It is working

NEGATIVE

I'm not working

You/We/They aren't working

He/She/It isn't working

QUESTION

Am I } working?
Are you/we/they }
Is he/she/it }

SHORT ANSWER

Yes, { I am
You/We/They are
He/She/It is
