Example:

- *Hi, I am from England.*
- *Nice!, what is the **capital city** of England?*
- *London*
- *-Awesome! Chile's capital city is Santiago. How is the **climate** in England?*

Keep asking questions using the new vocabulary.

- ✚ Name one real life situation in which you could use the new vocabulary given, give an example
